**Conditions:**

- 1) The Mike or Amplifier may be used at Puja Pandal considering Government rules from 6.00 AM to 10.00 PM. Sound Limiter must be used.
- 2) Subscription should be collected from willing persons only. Application of force will not be appreciated.
- 3) Subscription must not be collected from vehicles on road.
- 4) Fire extinguisher must be arranged at Puja Pandal. Adequate quantity of loose sand to be piled to arrest any accidental fire.
- 5) Sufficient number of volunteers should be engaged to maintain crowd.
- 6) The Idol immersion should be done on mentioned date from 13/11/2021 - 14/11/2021 positively.
- 7) The Puja Committee should intimate the local Police Station for Idol immersion along with procession.
- 8) Electric connections throughout the Pandal have to be made by an experienced and licensed electrician.
- 9) Arrangement of substitute electricity should be there in Puja Pandal for load-setting
- 10) The income & expenditure of the last puja have to be submitted.
- 11) Use of explosive crackers will not be allowed in the Puja Pandal premises.
- 12) There must not be any use of DJ boxes.
- 13) CC Cameras may also be installed at strategic locations on consultation with police authority.
- 14) Strictly follow the guideline of the Govt. of W.B. and as well as ICMR to prevent the spread of COVID-19

In reference to his/her application dated 11/11/2021 this is to inform him/her that the permission is allowed to use sound amplifying system on/from 13/11/2021 - 14/11/2021. On the following conditions as per order of the Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata dated 20.11.91 No. 4303(V) of 1995 and G.O. No. 373913/VPB-0/96 dt. 3.3.2004 of West Bengal Pollution Control Board. Necessary legal actions will be taken by the appropriate authority in case of any breach of terms and conditions as laid down.

1. Most of the sound amplifying system must be stereo boxes and only for announcement not more than two loud speakers will be allowed to be placed.

2. The Permissible noise limit as per Government of West Bengal vide No. EN/709/T-IV-6/001/2007 (Pt. 11) dt. 8.03.2010 is given below.


**Note-I** Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m.

**Note-II** Night time is reckoned in between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

**Note-III** 'Silence Zone' is an area comprising not less than 100 meters around Hospital, Educational Institutions, Courts, Religious Places or any other area which is declared as such by the competent authority.

**Note-IV** Mixed categories of areas may be declared as one of the four above mentioned categories by the competent authority.

3. Sound limiter machine should be affixed with amplifier/ stereo boxes/ as per order of Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata.
